The forged billet aluminum body with four stainless steel pistons weighs only 3.50 pounds. The 6.36 sq. in. surface area brake pads clamp down on your choice of 11" diameter Ultralite 30-vane plain or SRP drilled and slotted rotors. Calipers are available in red or black powder coat, or 22 additional color options. All-inclusive kits include DOT approved stainless steel braided flexlines, all mounting hardware and a detailed instruction guide.
